The Human Resources Department, Workers' Compensation Division is committed to providing high quality medical care to our injured employees. We are pleased to announce our partnership with CorVel Corporation to utilize their Medical Provider Network. As part of our continuing effort to improve services and in response to employee requests, arrangements have been made for injured employees to have the option of receiving medical care at Kaiser Permanente/Occupational Clinic. You do not have to be a Kaiser member to access the clinic for injury care. Additional information regarding the referral process to Kaiser's Occupational Clinic will be available on the Workforce Exchange webpage at www.workforceexchange.net.

The MPN Program was created by the legislature to offer greater choice to employees over their medical care for industrial injuries, including the option of selecting to pre-designate your own personal treating physician. Please review the enclosed information if you prefer to pre-designate your personal physician.

Enclosed is a summary outlining your MPN benefits and an Employee Acknowledgement form which must be returned to CorVel Corporation or the Workers' Compensation Division.
